### Commitment to achieving Net Zero

**The Standing CT Company is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2030.**

The Standing CT Company began tracking and reporting carbon emissions in 2020, working with C Level (Carbon Consultancy) to measure Scope 1,2 and 3 emissions which we report on annually.

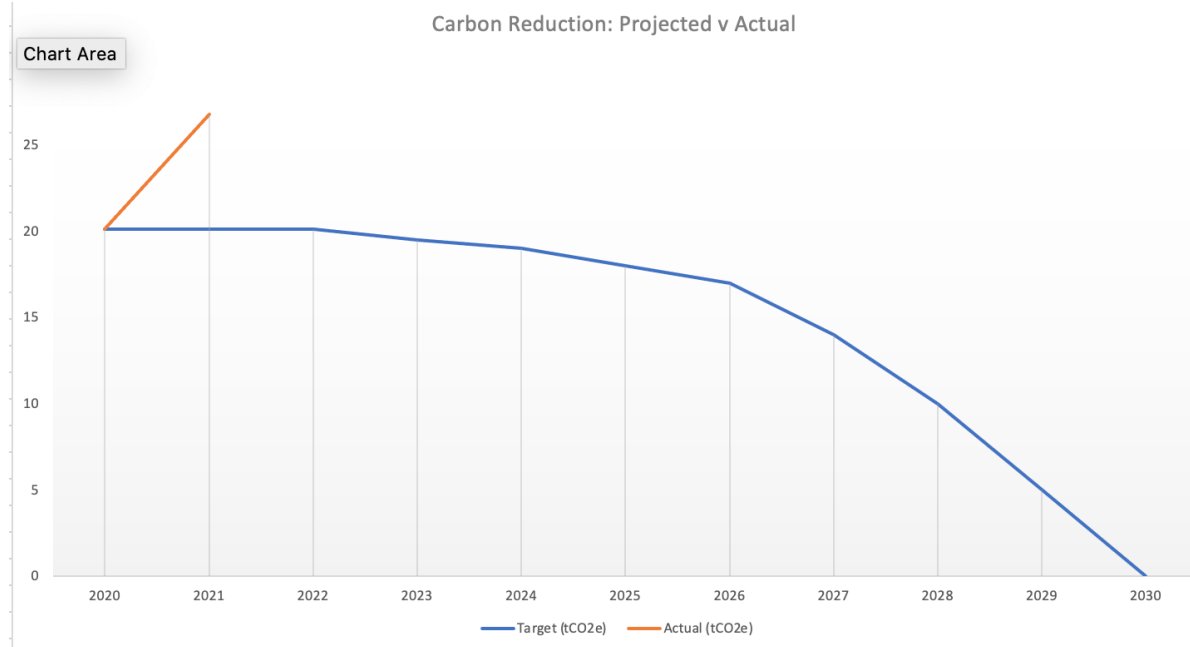
## Emissions reduction targets

**In order to progress to achieve Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.**

SCT have committed to be Net Zero by 2030. SCT are looking to make continuous improvements initially on carbon intensity and then on absolute reductions. SCT double offset the total current emissions and have done this since the company started tracking carbon emissions in 2020.

**We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 17 tCO<sub>2</sub>e by 2026. This is a reduction of 35% from 2021.**

## Carbon Reduction Projects

### Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Our Carbon reduction planning was initiated in 2021/22 and the initiatives are described in the paragraph below.

Going forward our carbon reduction initiatives are as follows:

- All permanent (non-bank) employees who travel for business to be in electric cars by the end of 2023
- All permanent (non-bank) employees to be on a green home electricity tariff by 2024
- All bank and contract staff who travel for business to be in electric cars by 2027
- All bank and contract staff to be on a green home electricity tariff by 2027
- Electric vehicles to be in place for towing of mobile units by 2030
- Solar panels to be fitted on all new mobile units from 2023
- Solar panels to be retrofitted to existing mobile units by 2025
- 50% of suppliers to be B Corps by 2023
- 75% of suppliers to be B Corp or effective net zero by 2027
- 90% of suppliers to be B Corp or effective net zero by 2030
- Road freight deliveries to be carbon neutral by 2027
- All freight deliveries to be carbon neutral by 2030
- Supplier of scanners to be carbon neutral by 2027
- Supplier of mobile units to be carbon neutral by 2030

In addition to the commitment to be net zero by 2030, as a B Corp SCT is committed to the Race to Net Zero and are signed up to the SME Climate Hub as a participant.

## Declaration and Sign Off


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
